As you probably know, the **17th Global Inspiration Conference, GIC**, organised under the umbrella of the International Breathwork Foundation, IBF, will take place from **the 3 to 10 of July 2010** in **Cardona, Barcelona (Spain)**.

Throughout this special week, the **GIC** offers to all its participants a **space of exchange of information, personal and professional experience** through workshops, lectures, gatherings, etc. The way those encounters of exchange are organised is organically organized on site, day after day, so that each person who wants to contribute has the possibility to offer their knowledge, new information or their working experience with the participants.

- New information not yet presented in previous GICs.
- Given the spirit of collaboration and exchange of IBF, the presence of the speaker as a participant in the GIC and during the maximum possible number of days will be valued.

The selected keynote speakers will receive as acknowledgment for their contribution 1 day/night free under full board regimen, which will be deducted from the total amount due for their participation and lodging at the GIC.

If you feel called by this offer, we ask you to please fill in the form attached to this letter in Annex 1, as soon as possible.

After **October 1st of 2009**, you will be notified of whether your proposal has been or not selected for the event. Remember that, in case it is not selected, you can always offer it to the group during the open time and space dedicated to it during the GIC.
